COMMENTS OF GULF POWER COMPANY

Gulf Power Company, ("Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Order No. PSC-96-0628-NOR-EU, issued May 9, 1996, Gulf Power Company submits the following written comments or suggestions on the proposed amendments to the Florida Public Service Commission's rule regarding adequacy of supply. These comments are submitted in lieu of a request for hearing.

As stated on page 3 of the May 9 Order, the intended purpose and effect of the proposed rule change is to codify "... reserve margin criteria and other policies concerning the planning practices and operating reserves of <u>Peninsular Florida's generating electric utilities</u> in Commission Order No. PSC- 94-1256-FOF-EU." [Emphasis added] That order was issued October 11, 1994 in Docket No. 940345-EU which was entitled "Investigation into Planning and Operating Reserve Practices of Peninsular Florida Generating Electric Utilities." Gulf Power was neither a party to nor included within the scope of that proceeding.

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

In order to make the proposed rule fully consistent with the stated intent, Gulf Power Company suggests the following minor modification to the proposed rule as stated in Order No.

PSC-96-0628-NOR-EU1:

25-6.035 Adequacy of <u>Resources</u> Supply. (1) Each utility shall maintain sufficient generating capacity, supplemented by regularly available generating and non-generating resources, in order to meet all reasonable demands for service and provide a reasonable reserve for emergencies. Each utility in Peninsular Florida shall also coordinate the sharing of energy reserves with other utilities in Peninsular Florida.²

The change suggested above would avoid an apparent unintentional implied broadening of the scope of the order that is being codified by the proposed rule. Gulf Power is suggesting this slight modification to the proposed rule in order to avoid the need for a hearing on this matter.
