

GTE FLORIDA INCORPORATED'S AMENDMENTS TO ITS PETITION FOR TEMPORARY WAIVER AND IMPLEMENTATION EXTENSION

On July 24, 1996, GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) filed a Petition seeking a temporary waiver of the Commission's requirement to maintain the status quo on carriage of interexchange traffic for one small portion of the Tampa-Central to San Antonio and Dade City extended calling service (ECS) routes that are to be implemented under Order number PSC-96-0557-FOF-TL. GTEFL also asked for a six-week extension to implement ECS on its Tampa-Central routes, as well as the Tampa-North to San Antonio and Dade City routes, and the Boca Grande to Englewood route.

Since filing its Petition, GTEFL has learned certain details that require revision to two statements in the Petition. These factual amendments follow.

First, GTEFL's Petition stated that, for one small area of the Tampa-Central exchange, the Company's existing switch technology associated with ECS implementation would mean that customers temporarily would not be able to dial their interLATA carriers through the "1+" or 10XXX prefixes. GTEFL has now determined that its switch will, in fact, allow customers to dial carriers through 10XXX prefixes, despite the deployment of ECS. In other words, the technical limitations are not as great as GTEFL previously believed.

Second, GTEFL stated that the software needed to resolve the switch problems was projected to be released in December 1996. GTEFL has now received a firmer release date of August 1997.

GTEFL renews its request for a temporary waiver of the interexchange carriage condition, and a brief delay in implementation of the Tampa-North, Tampa-Central, and Englewood ECS routes. These factual amendments do not weaken GTEFL's rationale for granting its Petition. To the contrary, as noted above, because customers will have a greater ability to reach their interLATA carriers than originally believed, the waiver GTEFL seeks will be that much less of a deviation from the Commission's order.
