COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida

Administrative Code, files its Motion for Extension of Time, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

- 1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-96-0933-PCO-TP in this proceeding, supplemental direct testimony limited to the impact of the order of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") in Common Carrier Docket Nos. 96-98 and 95-185 is due to be filed on August 16, 1996. Rebuttal testimony of the parties is due on August 23, 1996.
