5	Q.	PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME AND BUSINESS ADDRESS.
6	A.	My name is Mark Eugene Johnson. My business address is 600
7		Hidden Ridge, Irving, TX 75038.

9	Q.	BY WHOM ARE YOU EMPLOYED AND WHAT IS YOUR
10		POSITION?
11	Α.	I work for GTE Telephone Operations as Network Planning Manger-

1	Q.	DID YOU FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY IN THIS PROCEEDING?
2	Α.	No, I did not. However, I am adopting the Direct Testimony of GTE
3		witness Julia Ann Lawrence in this proceeding.
4		
5	Q.	SHOULD GTE BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE DIRECTORY
6		ASSISTANCE SERVICE, AS IT IS OFFERED TODAY, TO SPRINT
7		FOR RESALE?
8	A.	Yes. As GTE's resale witness, Doug Wellemeyer, testified, GTE is
9		willing to offer directory assistance (DA) service for resale, but not a
10		wholesale rates. It would be unreasonable to expect GTE to waive
11		charges to Sprint for disabled Sprint customers' calls to GTE's DA
12		service. GTE, as the wholesaler, will bill Sprint for all DA events. It
13		Sprint chooses to waive charges to all, some, or none of their
14		customer base, that is its decision.
15		
16	Q.	DOES THAT CONCLUDE YOUR REBUTTAL TESTIMONY?
17	A.	Yes, it does.
