## Re: Commonwealth Long Distance Company

Dear Sir or Madam:

Commonwealth Long Distance Company ("CLD") holds a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Florida. See Order No. PSC-95-0233-FOF-TI in Docket No. 941278-TI, issued February 20, 1995. As previously reported by letter dated August 19, 1996, CLD is a Pennsylvania corporation and a wholly-owned subsidiary of C-TEC Corporation ("C-TEC"), a publicly-traded company. Kiewit Telecom Services Inc., formerly known as RCN Corporation ("Kiewit Telecom"), holds approximately 57 percent of the outstanding voting interests in C-TEC, and Peter Kiewit Sons', Inc. ("PKS") holds a controlling interest in Kiewit Telecom.

C-TEC has announced that it intends to reorganize, subject to regulatory approval, by dividing the company into three separate publicly-traded companies. Pursuant to that reorganization, CLD will become a third-tier subsidiary of RCN Corporation, one of the newly created public companies. Specifically, CLD will maintain its corporate existence, but will become a wholly owned subsidiary of C-TEC Cable Systems of Pennsylvania, Inc., which will be a wholly owned subsidiary of C-TEC Financial Services, Inc., which in turn will be a wholly owned subsidiary of RCN Corporation. Kiewit Telecom, which changed its name in order to allow the new publicly traded parent company to be named RCN Corporation, will hold approximately 49 percent of the outstanding voting shares of RCN Corporation after the reorganization. The company hopes to complete the reorganization by July 1, 1997.

CLD does not anticipate any significant change in its Officers or Board of Directors as a result of the reorganization. CLD will continue to provide intrastate telecommunications services pursuant to its certification in Florida, but intends to change its name to RCN Long Distance Company. CLD is in the process of notifying state corporation authorities of its name change and will implement the name change once approvals have been obtained from all relevant states. CLD also intends to notify its customers of the name change by including an announcement in the customer's billing statement at least thirty days prior to using the new business name on customer bills. CLD will file appropriate tariff revisions reflecting the new name at that time.
