- <u>ISSUE 1</u>: Does the off-system sale agreement with the City of Lakeland provide net benefits to Tampa Electric's general body of rate payers?
- ISSUE 2: Does the off-system sale agreement with the Florida Municipal Power Agency provide net benefits to Tampa Electric's general body of rate payers?
- ISSUE 3: What should be the appropriate regulatory treatment for the costs and revenues associated with the sale to the City of Lakeland?
- ISSUE 4: What should be the appropriate regulatory treatment for the costs and revenues associated with the sale to the Florida Municipal Power Agency?
