IDENTIFICATION OF ISSUES**


Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") identifies the following as issues to be resolved in this proceeding:

- ISSUE 1:** Does the off-system sale agreement with the City of Lakeland provide net benefits to Tampa Electric's general body of rate payers?
- ISSUE 2:** Does the off-system sale agreement with the Florida Municipal Power Agency provide net benefits to Tampa Electric's general body of rate payers?
- ISSUE 3:** What should be the appropriate regulatory treatment for the costs and revenues associated with the sale to the City of Lakeland?
- ISSUE 4:** What should be the appropriate regulatory treatment for the costs and revenues associated with the sale to the Florida Municipal Power Agency?
