

Staff has filed a recommendation for Docket No. 960907-WS, which is scheduled for the April 14, 1997 Agenda Conference, as Item No. 34. This recommendation addresses a territory amendment by Florida Water Services Corporation (formerly Southern States Utilities, Inc. and hereafter Florida Water) and the stipulation between Florida Water and the City of Cape Coral.

This amendment application includes the Marina Hotel and the Burnt Store Colony (the Colony). The Colony was granted an exemption by the Public Service Commission in Docket No. 960057 by Order No. PSC-97-0035-FOF-WS, dated January 7, 1997. The Colony will be selling and transferring its water lines to Florida Water and shutting down its water treatment plant. After further consideration, staff believes that the transfer of water lines should be addressed in the recommendation. Therefore, staff requests that Item No. 34 be deferred.
