J3 Communications, Inc. was formed in 1996 to provide long distance service bundled with other telecommunications products. A long distance product bundled with Internet access was introduced on January 25, 1997. The pricing model employed certain assumptions that were not viable. In addition, it became apparent that major organizational changes were necessary in order to make modifications to the pricing and structure of the company. Accordingly, on March 19, 1997, the shareholders of J3 Communications, Inc. voted to remove and replace all directors and officers of the corporation.

Since March 19, 1997, we have tried, unsuccessfully, to reorganize J3 Communications, Inc. J3 Communications has no profit center, income stream, staff or employees. In addition, it has more than \$200,000 in debt and no recoverable assets. Regrettably, J3 Communications, Inc. has no alternative but to cease operations.
