TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

1. On May 12, 1997 Staff filed and served their Amended First Set of Interrogatories. On May 22, 1997 Tampa Electric filed its response and objections to Staff's discovery, including a specific objection to amended Interrogatory No. 5 asking the company to provide the monthly incremental fuel costs separated by f.o.b. mine price, transportation cost and net profit to affiliates of Tampa Electric for the FMPA and Lakeland sales from the inception of the sales through February 28, 1997.

2. During the June 11, 1997 hearing in this docket Chairman Johnson granted Staff's motion to compel Tampa Electric to answer amended Interrogatory No. 5 as a Late-Filed Exhibit No. 6. (Tr. 190)

3. Tampa Electric is simultaneously filing under a separate cover letter its confidential answer to amended Interrogatory No. 5 along with a justification for treating the information contained therein as proprietary confidential business information.

4. Under Commission Rule 25-22.006(6)(b), this request for a protective order exempts the response to amended Interrogatory No. 5 from the Public Records Law.

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5. Tampa Electric also requests that the Florida Industrial Power Users Group be afforded access to the company's answer to amended Interrogatory No. 5 only after such time as an appropriate confidentiality agreement is executed on behalf of FIPUG. The undersigned is this date providing counsel for FIPUG with a proposed confidentiality agreement.

6. Also, pursuant to Fla. Admin. Code Rule 25-22.006(6)(d), Tampa Electric's confidential response to amended Interrogatory No. 5 should be returned to the company no later than 60 days after the final order in this docket. Such return is also contemplated in the Order Establishing Procedure and in the Prehearing Order in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company requests the entry of a protective order containing the above protection relative to the company's response to Staff's amended Interrogatory No. 5 (hearing Late-Filed Exhibit No. 6). DATED this 200 day of July, 1997.
