RE: DOCKET NO. 970621-TI - Initiation of show cause proceedings against American Telecommunications Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a American Telecom for violation of Rules 25-24.630(1)(a) and 25-24.480, F.A.C.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept ATI's settlement proposal?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept the terms of ATI's settlement, with the requirement that ATI submit a verification report confirming ATI has Issued \$4,906.92 in refunds or credits, as calculated in Attachment B of staff's memorandum dated July 2, 1997, within 90 days of the effective date of the Commission's order. Additionally, the Commission should require ATI to pay the settlement amount of \$18,988.72, within 90 days of the effective date of the Commission's order, with the monies to be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund in accordance with Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.
