Prehearing Statement of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), in compliance with the Order Establishing Procedure (Order No. PSC-97-0721-PCO-TP) issued June 19, 1997, submits its Prehearing Statement for Docket Nos. 970172-TP, 970173-TP and 970281-TL.

A. Witnesses

BellSouth proposes to call the following witness to offer testimony on the issues set forth in this matter:

Thomas F. Lohman (Direct and Rebuttal)

All issues

BellSouth reserves the right to call witnesses to respond to Commission inquiries not addressed in direct or rebuttal testimony and witnesses to address issues not presently designated that may be designated by the Prehearing Officer at the prehearing conference to be held on July 30, 1997.

B. Exhibits

TFL-1 Florida Payphone Subsidy Calculation

BellSouth reserves the right to file exhibits to any testimony that may be filed under the circumstances identified in Section "A" above. BellSouth also reserves the right to introduce exhibits for cross-examination, impeachment, or any other purpose authorized by the applicable Florida Rules of Evidence and Rules of this Commission.

C. Statement of Basic Position

The amount of intrastate payphone subsidy in BellSouth's rates is \$6,501,000. BellSouth submits that FCC Order 96-388 requires incumbent LECs to remove any intrastate payphone subsidy from intrastate rates. It is this Commission's duty to determine the intrastate rates that must be reduced to fully remore the subsidy. BellSouth filed and this Commission approved a tariff filing reducing BellSouth's intrastate hunting rates by the amount of the subsidy. BellSouth's tariff filing is appropriate, beneficial to end users, was properly approved by this Commission, and is consistent with the requirements of the FCC Order.

D. BellSouth's Position on the Issues

Issue No. 1: What is the amount of intrastate payphone subsidy, if any, that needs to be eliminated by each local exchange company pursuant to Section 276(B)(1)(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996?

<u>Position</u>: The amount of intrastate payphone subsidy in BellSouth's rates is \$6,501,000.

Issue No. 2: If an intrastate payphone subsidy is identified in Issue

1, do the FCC's Payphone Reclassification Orders require the Florida

Public Service Commission to specify which rate element(s) should be reduced to eliminate such subsidy?

Position: The FCC's Order states that the subsidy must be removed from intrastate rates. This Commission has authority, under the Order, to determine what elements should be reduced in order to eliminate the subsidy. The Commission has exercised that authority by reducing BellSouth's hunting charges.

Issue No. 3: If an intrastate payphone subsidy is identified in Issue 1, what is the appropriate rate element(s) to be reduced to eliminate such subsidy?

Position: Business huriting charges.

Issue No. 4: If necessary, by what date should revised intrastate tariffs that eliminate any identified intrastate payphone subsidy be filed?

Position: The intrastate tariff filed by BellSouth that became effective April

1, 1997 and was approved by the Commission serves as BellSouth's filing. No
additional filing should be required of BellSouth.

Issue No. 5: Is April 15, 1997, the appropriate effective date for revised intrastate tariffs that eliminate any identified intrastate payphone subsidy?

Position: In general yes, however, the effective date for BellSouth was April 1, 1997.

Issue No. 6: Should this docket be closed?

Position: Yes.

E. Stipulations

There are no stipulations of which BellSouth is aware.

F. Pending Motions

There are no pending motions at this time.

G. Other Requirements

BellSouth knows of no requirement set forth in any prehearing order with which it cannot comply.
