The letter states that it is a notice of application for the extension of their service area. It lists all of the areas of Rainbow Springs that water and sewer will be extended to, but also says this should have been sent out 16 years ago.

I have contacted RBS utilities and they told me that I could throw this letter away, because it meant absolutely nothing and would have no effect on the area where we live. That is a lie! It states that all of section 7 is in this service area and my property description is, SECTION 07 - TWP 16 - RANGE 19- BLOCK 114 LOT 10.

I was told at the Sales Office of RBS, that a new section was to be developed that is directly east of where we live, that will have small lots which require water and sewer, so I am sure that they will make us connect also, even though our properties are over 1 acre in size and we have a well and septic tank, that we have had to pay for when we built our house.

I am sure that a lot of residents of RBS will also be writing letters of protest and I request that you people at the Florida Public Service Commission delay any action on this matter until the property owners of RBS can get more truthful information on how this will affect us on our property with respect to when, where, and how much it will cost.

I will also be sending this letter and attachments to the following elected officials to make them aware that a developer cannot do whatever he wants and pass on the costs to everyone living in their communities.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and the provisions of Florida Public Service Commission Rule 25-30.030. Notice is hereby given by Rainbow Springs Utilities, L.C., 8625 SW 200th Circle, Dunnellon, Florida 34431-5325, of its Application to extend its service area to provide water and sewer service to the following described lands in Marion County, Florida:

A parcel of land lying in Sections 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23 and 24, Township 16 South, Range 18 East, and lying in Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 18 and 19, Township 16 South, Range 19 East, all in Marion County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

In said Section 3: the South 1/2, less and except the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 thereof;

AND

In said Section 10: the East 1/2; the Southwest 1/4; and the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4;

AND

In said Section 11: the West 1/2;

AND

In said Section 12: the South 1/2; the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4; that portion of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 lying East of US Highway No. 41; the South 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4; and that portion of the North 3/4 of the Northeast 1/4 lying West of the right-of-way for Atlantic Coast Line Railroad;
