On December 23, 1997 we received notice of the proposal to extend water and sewer service to our area. As property owners in the Woodland's section of Rainbow Springs in Marion County, we are opposed to this plan.

Not only was the timing of this notice inappropriate, the holidays, but it should have been sent certified-return receipt thus insuring that all owners did receive notification. Allowing thirty days for written objections gives little time considering the season. We, therefore, request that the Florida Public Service Commission delay any formal action on this matter until the property owners of the Woodlands have time to organize a plan to defeat the extension of service as proposed by the Rainbow Springs Utilities L.C.
