This letter is to follow up our conversation regarding the refunds to the customers. As you can see from the enclosed, to date I have calculated interest on the refunds in the amount of \$7,011.29. This includes interest on the water and wastewater refunds as well as the refunds of the interest on the customer deposits, the miscellaneous service charges and the late fee. I have estimated the interest for January since Wall Street Journal has not yet published an interest rate for January.

In addition, I have enclosed a copy of Order No. PSC-93-1769-FOF-WS, issued December 9, 1993. As you can see on page 3 of the order, the Commission determined that all unclaimed refunds be forwarded to the City of Alachua for further disposition. This is consistent with Rule 25-

CK . FA . PP . CAF . CMU	30.360(8), Florida Administrative Code, which states "any unclaimed refunds shall be treated as cash contributions in aid of construction (CIAC)." As I explained in our telephone conversation, since Turkey Creek Utilities no longer has any investment in the utility, the utility cannot treat the unclaimed refunds as CIAC. Accordingly, it is appropriate that the unclaimed refunds be forwarded to the city, which now owns the utility. Please be reminded that this order was appealed by Turkey Creek Utilities to the First District Court of Appeal and was subsequently upheld by the court.
	Therefore, the court has agreed that it is appropriate for the city to receive the unclaimed refunds.
CTR	Lastly, I have enclosed a copy of Rule 25-30.360, Florida Administrative Code. This rule
EAG LEC	governs the disposition of refunds. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360(7), Florida Administrative Code,
LIN	once Turkey Creek has completed the refunds, it must file a preliminary report within 30 days of completing the refund and again 90 days thereafter. Once all administrative aspects of the report
A	are completed, a final report shall be made. All reports must specify:

- a. The amount of money to be refunded and how that amount was computed;
- b. The amount of money actually refunded;
- c. The amount of any unclaimed refunds; and
- d. The status of any unclaimed amounts.
