> Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-98-0300-PCO-TL at its March 24, 1998, Agenda Conference.

- 2. The Commission's decision on reconsideration, as well as the discovery responses, will not only have significant bearing on the substance of staff's testimony, but will also determine which staff members are called upon to be witnesses in this case. As a practical matter, staff would like to avoid losing staff members from the analysis portion of this case to become witnesses unless it is clearly necessary.
- 3. Furthermore, staff believes that if its request for an extension of time is granted, the remaining filing dates established by Order No. PSC-98-0300-PCO-TL should be moved in the interest of fairness to all parties. Staff believes that the dates could be moved without affecting the hearing or prehearing dates. Staff suggests the following modifications:
