Staff believes the following recommendations are appropriate. DISCUSSION OF ISSUES ISSUE 1: Should the Commission grant each of the providers listed on page 4 a waiver from the requirement that each telephone station shall allow incoming calls for the pay telephone numbers at the addresses listed? RECOMMENDATION: Yes. (Isler) STAFF ANALYSIS: Rule 25-24.515(8), Florida Administrative Code, provides in the pertinent part; Each telephone station shall allow incoming calls to be received, with the exception of those located at penal institutions, hospitals and schools, and at locations specifically exempted by the Commission. There shall be no charge for receiving incoming calls. Requests for exemption from the requirement that each telephone station allow incoming calls shall be accompanied by a completed FORM PSC/CMU-2 (12/94), which is incorporated into this rule by reference. Each company has submitted a properly completed Request to Block Incoming Calls form for each of the instruments identified on page 4. Staff has reviewed each form and found each to have been signed by the owner or officer of the pay telephone company, - 2 -
