NOW COMES, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), and

responds to the Motion of MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. ("MCI") to

Expedite Hearing Schedule in the above captioned matter. In response thereto,

BellSouth states the following:

1. MCI filed its Complaint on February 23, 1998. On March 20, 1998, the

Commission issued a case schedule calling for a hearing on October 8-9, 1998 and the issuance of an order on December 21, 1998.

2. MCI claims that the Commission's hearing schedule will delay its ability to "bring local competition to Florida." BellSouth avers that MCI has delayed entering the Florida market for reasons other than the imaginary obstacles claimed by MCI.

3. While BellSouth does not necessarily oppose MCI's desire for an expedited hearing schedule, BellSouth does oppose a schedule that calls for a final order to be issued by June 30, 1998. BellSouth is involved in several cases that are going to hearing in April, May, and June. MCI's requested schedule would burden BellSouth's resources.
