ORDER ADDING DOCKET NO. 930173-TL TO CONSOLIDATED PROCEEDING FOR HEARING PURPOSES ONLY

The Commission suspended action in a number of dockets pending review of the impact of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act) on pending requests for interLATA extended area service (EAS) on BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) routes. There was some concern that under Section 271 of the Act, Bell operating companies (BOCs) are clearly prohibited from originating interLATA traffic until the BOCs meet certain conditions. Under Section 272 of the Act, even after it meets the requirements of Section 271, a BOC may only originate interLATA telecommunications services through a separate and independent affiliate. On November 18, 1996, the Commission staff conducted a workshop on this matter. After thoroughly reviewing the Act, the issues presented, and the comments filed by the workshop participants, by Order No. PSC-97-

0622-FOF-TL, issued May 30, 1997, the Commission determined that BellSouth should be relieved of certain requirements set forth in Order No. PSC-96-0557-FOF-TL, because of the Act's impact on BellSouth's ability to carry interLATA traffic.

On July 15, 1997, the FCC issued Order 97-244. addressed several petitions for modification of LATA boundaries to allow Ameritech, Bell Atlantic, BellSouth, Southwestern Bell, and US West to provide expanded local calling service. Therein, the FCC determined that the need for certain expanded local calling routes outweighed any anticompetitive risks, and therefore, it approved 23 of the requests to modify LATA boundaries. approving these requests, the FCC emphasized that the LATAs were being modified solely to allow the BOCs to offer non-optional, flat rate local calling service. Any other types of service offered between the identified exchanges would still be considered interLATA. See FCC Order 97-244 at ¶ 19. In addition, in Section V of Order 97-244, Future LATA Modification Requests, the FCC set forth specific guidelines to assist BOCs in filing future LATA modification petitions.

In view of the FCC's apparent willingness to continue to consider requests for modification of LATA boundaries to allow BOCs to provide expanded local calling, the Commission has revived action in certain EAS dockets upon which the Commission had not taken final action. The Commission had, however, already made post-hearing decisions in certain dockets. Thus, in order to resolve the dockets identified in this Order, we have scheduled a hearing on May 27, 1998, to consider the feasibility of one-way ECS, since two-way, flat rate, nonoptional EAS is not warranted.

By Order No. PSC-97-1462-PCO-TL, issued November 20, 1997, the procedure for these dockets was established. In addition, for purposes of administrative efficiency, and in view of the fact that the final determination in these dockets is dependent upon the outcome of our hearing, Docket Nos. 870248-TL, 870790-TL, 900039-TL, 910022-TL, 910528-TL, 910529-TL, 911185-TL, and 921193-TL were consolidated for hearing purposes only.

Thereafter, at our April 7, 1998, Agenda Conference, we made our post-hearing decision in Docket No., 930173-TL. We determined that the routes at issue in that Docket did not demonstrate a sufficient community of interest to warrant surveying for EAS. We did, however, decide that certain routes, including the Orlando

routes, which are served by BellSouth, warranted ECS. The Orlando routes are interLATA routes; therefore, BellSouth is prohibited from originating ECS traffic on these routes. Thus, we determined that Docket No. 930173-TL should remain open pending the outcome of our determination regarding the feasibility of one-way ECS. In view of our decision at our April 7, 1998, Agenda Conference, Docket No. 930173-TL shall be added to the dockets consolidated for hearing on the issue of the feasibility of one-way ECS. Following the hearing, action taken in any one docket shall be independent of action taken in the other dockets.

Based upon the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Commissioner J. Terry Deason, as Prehearing Officer, that Docket No. 930173-TL is added to the consolidated proceeding that includes Docket Nos. 870248-TL, 870790-TL, 900039-TL, 910022-TL, 910528-TL, 910529-TL, 911185-TL, and 921193-TL. These dockets are consolidated for hearing purposes only.

This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: 1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; 2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or 3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
