On approximately April 3, 1998, the owners of Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc. received Notice of Proposed Extension of Service Territory of Florida Water Services for its water and wastewater systems in Marion County, Florida. Included within the description of the territory proposed for service was a large portion of existing service territory of Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc. as granted by the Public Service Commission in its Order No. PSC-96-0958-FOF-WS issued on July 24, 1996 (The Preserve).

We have contacted representatives of Florida Water Services NCK \_\_\_\_\_ and have verified that in fact the inclusion of the existing water AFA \_ and wastewater service territory of Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc. into the proposed extension area was inadvertent. As such, it APP is our understanding that by letter dated April 28, 1998, Florida CAF ----Water Services has filed a Restrictive Amendment to its Application and removed from its proposed service territory extension those CMU \_\_\_ areas previously granted to Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc. CTR \_

EAG To the extent that the Restrictive Amendment has been filed to exclude the entirety of Spruce Creek South's territory, and to the LEG extent that is accepted by the PSC, Spruce Creek South Utilities, LIN -fnc. does not wish to protest the proposed extension. However, to the extent that any of the existing service territory of Spruce OPC Creek South Utilities, Inc. remains within the proposed extension RCH. area of Florida Water Services in this docket, please consider this as Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc.'s protest of that proposed WASKerlomentension.
