MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. (MCImetro) hereby files its prehearing statement in accordance with the requirements of Order No. PSC-98-0561-PCO-TP.

B. <u>Known Witnesses</u>. MCImetro has prefiled the direct and rebuttal testimony of Ron Martinez. Mr. Martinez will testify in regard to Issue 3.

C. <u>Known Exhibits</u>. MCImetro has prefiled the following exhibit:

Martinez RM-1 Excerpts from the MCImetro/ BellSouth Interconnection Agreement

MCI reserves the right to use additional exhibits for purposes of cross-examination.

D. <u>Basic Position</u>. BellSouth and MCImetro must pay each other reciprocal compensation for the termination of ISP traffic. MCImetro and BellSouth agreed to the definition of Local Traffic contained in Attachment IV, Subsection 2.2.1, of the Agreement. In fact, it was BellSouth which proposed the definition. MCImetro and BellSouth further agreed to pay reciprocal compensation for telephone calls which meet that definition of local traffic. Telephone calls to an ISP meet that definition. Had an exception been intended for ISP traffic (or for any other subset of local traffic), it would have been expressly included by the parties. No such exception is contained in the Agreement and no such exception was ever suggested by BellSouth.

F. <u>Issues</u>. MCImetro's position on the issues identified in the Order on Procedure are as follows:

**Issue 1:** Under their Interconnection Agreement, are MFS and BellSouth required to compensate each other for transport and termination of traffic to ISPs? If so,

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what action, if any, should be taken? MCImetro: No position.

**Issue 2:** Under their Interconnection Agreement, are Teleport and BellSouth required to compensate each other for transport and termination of traffic to ISPs? If so, what action, if any, should be taken?

MCImetro: No position.

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**Issue 3:** Under their Interconnection Agreement, are MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., and BellSouth required to compensate each other for transport and termination of traffic to ISPs? If so, what action, if any, should be taken?

MCImetro: Yes. BellSouth and MCImetro must pay each other reciprocal compensation for the termination of telephone calls to ISPs. The definition of Local Traffic in Attachment IV, Subsection 2.2.1, which was included at BellSouth's request, makes no exception for telephone calls terminated to ISPs. Had such an exception been intended, it would have been expressly included by the parties. BellSouth should be ordered to pay to MCImetro all outstanding charges for reciprocal compensation, with interest. Further, on a going forward basis, BellSouth should be ordered to continue to compensate MCImetro for such traffic in accordance with the Agreement.

**Issue 4:** Under their Interconnection Agreement, are Intermedia and BellSouth required to compensate each other for transport and termination of traffic to ISPs? If so, what action, if any, should be taken?

MCImetro: No position.

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E. <u>Stipulations</u>. There are no stipulations between MCI and any party at this time.

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F. <u>Pending Motions</u>. MCI has no pending motions at this time.

G. <u>Requirements of Order on Procedure</u>. MCI believes that this prehearing statement complies with all the requirements of the Order on Procedure.
