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PROCEEDINGS 1 (Hearing convened at 9:40 a.m.) 2 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Call the prehearing to 3 order. Ms. Brown or Ms. Pena, please read the notice. 4 MS. BROWN: By notice issued May 7th, 1998, 5 this time and place was set for a prehearing 6 conference in Docket No. 970109-TI in re: Application 7 for certificate to provide interexchange 8 telecommunications service by KTNT Communications, 9 Inc. doing business as IDC Telecommunications. 10 COMMISSIONER CLARK: We'll take appearances, 11 starting with you, Mr. Beck. 12 13 MR. BECK: My name is Charlie Beck with the Office of Public Counsel, 111 West Madison Street, 14 15 Room 812, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1400, appearing on behalf of the Florida citizens. 16 17 MR. GROSS: Michael Gross on behalf of the Attorney General's Office, PL-01, the Capitol, 18 19 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1050. 20 MR. WIGGINS: Patrick Wiggins, Wiggins & Viliacorta, P. O. Drawer 1657, on behalf of KTNT 21 22 Communications, et al. ::3 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. 24 MS BROWN: Martha Carter Brown on behalf of 25 the Florida Commission Staff.

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1	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Are ther any
2	preliminary matters we have to take up?
3	I have read the prehearing draft. It looks
4	okay to me. And I have been informed that the only
5	thing I had a question about, which was the protective
6	crder, has been taken care of.
7	MS. BROWN: That's my understanding,
8	Commissioner Clark.
9	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Then let me just ask.
10	Are there any changes to the Prehearing Order?
11	MR. BECK: Commissioner, I know of one. I
12	discussed with Mr. Wiggins about the order of
13	witnesses and putting them up. And I think we've
14	agreed that Mr. Dees would take the stand first and
15	present both his direct and rebuttal at the same time.
16	COMMISSIONER CLARK: That sounds good.
17	We'll note that.
18	MR. WIGGINS: I would like the opportunity
19	for a brief opening statement.
20	COMMISSIONER CLARK: We'll note that as
21	well. Is this before a panel or the whole Commission?
22	MS. BROWN: It's the full Commission.
23	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. When is it going
24	to be, the hearing?
25	MS. BROWN: The 28th.
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MR. WIGGINS: Maybe I just misre ad it, but I 1 2 thought I checked the Web site last night and I 3 thought it said it was before a panel of Commissioners. 4 5 MS. BROWN: Really? MR. WIGGINS: Yes. Commissioners Clark --6 7 MS. BROWN: I'm sorry. MR. WIGGINS: -- Jacobs and Deason. 8 MS. BROWN: That changes, I guess, without 9 my knowing. I'm sorry. It was originally 10 11 scheduled --COHMISSIONER CLARF: It might have been 12 13 changed. MR. WIGGINS: -- as the full Commission. 14 15 But it is the 28th. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Well, there's no 16 17 objection to the panel, then? 18 MR. WIGGINS: No. 19 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Beck, anything 20 else? 21 MR. BECK: That's all we have. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Mr. Gross? 22 MR. GROSS: The Attorney General joins with 23 24 Public Counsel. 25 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Gross, we didn't

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know if you were going to be here because it was a 1 joint filing, that's why we started. But welcome. 2 з MR. GROSS: I apologize for being late. MR. WIGGINS: Maybe I could, for just 4 hearing preparation purposes, inquire of you guys 5 whether both of you are going to be crossing Mr. Dees 6 or do you know yet? Have you talked about that or do 7 you think -- it's just going to be one of you? 8 MR. BECK: We haven't discussed it. I 9 10 assume we both have a opportunity. We filed separately -- although we filed a joint prehearing 11 12 statement, we've intervened separately. COMMISSIONFR CLARK: All right. 13 MR. WIGGINS: I think you both have a right 14 to cross. I was just curious as to whether you 15 16 thought about it. 17 MR. GROSS: I think we have an obligation to 18 avoid duplication. 19 MR. WIGGINS: Great. Unless, of course, it 20 helps ---21 CONMISSIONER CLARK: Is there anything else 2'. I need to take up? 23 MR. WIGGINS: Yes, ma'am. I do have a 24 sentence to add to our position on Issue 5, but I can 25 provide that to Ms. Brown, or I can read it into the

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1 record now.

2 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Why don't you read it 3 to the parties now.

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MR. WIGGINS: At the -- added at the very 4 end of the paragraph after the word "experience." 5 "In addition, attempting to restrict the use 6 of a valid service mark under these circumstances may 7 violate KTNT's right to commercial free speech." 8 9 MS. BROWN: Can I ask that be read one more time? 10 MR. WIGGINS: Sure. "In addition, 11 attempting to restrict the use of a valid service mark 12 under these circumstances may violate KTNT's right to 13 commercial free speech." 14 MS. BROWN: Thank you. 15 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Anything else? 16 MS. EROWN: Commissioner Clark, I just have 17 one other thing with respect to the opening 18 statements. Do you want to put a time limit on it? 19 MR. WIGGINS: I can't imagine going more 20 than five minutes on that. 21 22 MS. BROWN: You can't. COMMISSIONER CLARK: We'll put a time limit 23 of five minutes on it. 24 25 MB. BROWN: All right. Thank you.

1	CONMISSIONER CLARK: Anything else? This
2	prehearing is adjourned. Thank you very much.
3	MR. WIGGINS: Thank you.
