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## BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'s NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company") hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification for information produced in response to the Commission's universal service data request.

- 1. In a Memorandum dated May 4, 1998, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission"), requested that BellSouth provide it with the input values BellSouth believes are appropriate for BellSouth in the cost proxy model which will be used to determine the benchmark(s) to be used to yield the federal high-cost funding amounts for non-rural local exchange companies. In providing these inputs, BellSouth has relied in part on information concerning "contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the company or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms." Fla.St. § 364.183 (3)(d). The above information is competitively sensitive.
- The information being provided is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183, including but not limited to § 364.183(3)(d).
- Because this information is proprietary, BellSouth is filing this
