Blanca, I have learned that the 305 Area Code docket has been reopened to process a petition by BellSouth to extend the permissive dialing period. Staff's recommendation will be considered by the Commission at its June 16, 1998, Agenda Conference. The Agenda Conference will begin at 9:30 a.m. and is open to the public.

Commissioner Clark received your e-mail message about extending the permissive dialing period in the 305 Area Code. We have placed a copy on the record of the proceeding and have disseminated it to the parties.
