Dear Bob,

It has finally become painfully obvious that Mao Tse Tung's "Long March" was a walk in the park compared to the journey that we have embarked upon.

At our meeting Thursday, June 4 (at your request it was postponed from the 1st), it was agreed that your counsel would deliver settlement language by Tuesday, June 9, excluding only the engineering reports. We will, at this moment, instruct our attorney to proceed with legal proceedings against any and all parties, including the DEP (maybe they're the controlling legal authority) that have played a part in creating the cesspool referred to as Cove Lake.

This process will begin immediately and conclude only with a jury verdict or a signed document by Sanlando and/or its' principals, and subsequent acceptance by Sweetwater oaks Homeowners Association, detailing the clean-up effort, time schedules, plant revisions, future nutrient loadings, etc.
