BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- 1. On June 4, 1998, a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification was filed for Late Filed Deposition Exhibit No. 5 for Jerry Hendrix.
- 2. BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for the subject information because Late Filed Deposition Exhibit No. 5 contains proprietary customer specific information.
- 3. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing of the location of the information designated by BellSouth as proprietary.
- 4. Appended hereto as Attachment B is two copies of the requested documents with the proprietary information deleted.
- 5. Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the documents including the material which is proprietary.
- 6. The requested documents contain information considered to be proprietary to BellSouth, and includes, among other things, customer specific information. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would provide BellSouth's competitors with an unfair advantage.
