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Issue 2: Should the Commission deny Coral Communications, Inc.'s application for a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications service in Florida?
Recommendation: Yes. Coral does not appear to have the managerial capability required in Section 364.337(3), Florida Statutes. Therefore, the application should be denied.

Issue 3: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, Docket
No. 980336-TI should remain open pending resolution of the show cause
proceeding. Coral must respond to the original show cause order within '0
days of issuance of this Order denying the settlement. If Coral fails to
respond to the Show Cause Order, the fine should be deemed assessed. If
Coral fails to respond to the Order to Show Cause, and the fines are not
received within 5 business days after expiration of the show cause response
period, this docket should be closed administratively. After reasonable
collection efforts, the fine should be forwarded to the Comptroller's
Office for collection.

If staff's recommendation in Issue 2 is approved, Docket No. 980491-TI should remain open pending the processing of any protest to Issue 2 that may be filed within 21 days of issuance of the Order by a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's proposed agency action. If no protest is filed, the Order will become final, and this docket should be closed.
