I read recently where the PSC will soon have to add another area code to the Central Florida area due to the growing number of new phones, fax machines and cell phones.

I understand that when you are out of numbers, you are out of numbers and there are only so many seven digit number combinations. Also, I know that the PSC understands the costs to businesses and individuals associated with designating a new area code to a particular part of the state.

#### Would designating a new area code to *cell phones only* not relieve the problem?

- Business would not likely have to change company letterhead because cell phone numbers are not typically listed.
- Cell phones are a "luxury" to individuals; thus the opportunity cost associated with learning a new area code would be directed to cell phone users only.

I am not sure whether this idea has merit or not, but thought I would forward the question to professionals who deal with type of issue daily. Please feel free to contact me should have any questions.
