**WORLDCOM, INC.'S REQUEST FOR  
CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Now comes WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom, for itself and its affiliates/subsidiaries WorldCom Technologies, Inc., WorldCom Network Services, Inc., Biztel Corp. and TTI National, Inc. (hereinafter, collectively "WorldCom"), and files this Request for Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-98-0795-FOF-TP, issued June 8, 1998, all facilities-based interexchange carriers, including WorldCom, were required to file tariff reductions to flow-through access charge reductions ordered by the PSC.

2. WorldCom's supporting documentation for its tariff reductions, required by the Order, includes proprietary confidential business information which is exempt from public disclosure under Sections 119.07 and 364.183, Florida Statutes. The information is confidential because it relates to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair WorldCom's competitive business. The subject information identifies by carrier and service plan intrastate minutes of use and revenues that are used to calculate savings to the company, the amount of the aggregate required rate reduction, and the total value of the flow-through.

3. As required by Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, an unedited highlighted copy of this information is included in the envelope included with this Notice as Exhibit

1. Additionally two edited copies are also enclosed as Exhibit 2.



### IXC Summary

**IXCs:** WorldCom Technologies, Inc. (WTI); WorldCom Network Services, Inc. (WNS); Biztel Corp.; TTI National, Inc.

**Effective date of flow-through:** July 1, 1998

#### Percentage Reduction of IntraLATA toll rates

WorldCom only reduced interLATA rates for World One. For the other products WorldCom has only one rate schedule, therefore the percent reduction for intraLATA was no greater than interLATA.

#### Determination of Residence & Business Calculation

WorldCom determined what percentage of our Florida market was attributed to Commercial, Residential, Biztel, and Wholesale sectors. Then the total savings were allocated between each sector based on this percentage and then flowed through in the products listed. WorldOne, Biztel BUS 49, TTI's Combined Calling Plan, Classic Carrier Service, and Transcend products are part of the "business rate" summary below. Home Advantage is in the "residential rate" summary below. Please note that the Transcend product is a non-tariffed contract service for resellers.
