DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve BellSouth Telecommunications Inc.'s (BellSouth) emergency request to waive the late payment charges for its customers affected by the recent fires in the central east coast area?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, the Commission should approve BellSouth's emergency request to waive the late payment charges for sixty days to existing BellSouth customers affected by the recent fires in the central east coast area. BellSouth should file a tariff reflecting the sixty (60) day waiver of late payment charges. The tariff should be filed within five (5) days of this Agenda to be approved administratively with an effective date of July 21, 1998. (Barrett)

STAFF ANALYSIS: At the March 10, 1998 Agenda, the Commission authorized certain emergency waivers of charges to facilitate customers impacted by severe flooding. The procedures used in this recommendation are similar to those adopted by Order Nos. PSC-98-0394-FOF-TL (floods), PSC-95-1613-FOF-TP (Hurricane Opal), and PSC-92-0910-FOF-TL (Hurricane Andrew).

On July 7, 1998, BellSouth filed an emergency request to waive late payment charges for a period of sixty (60) days to existing BellSouth customers who have been affected by the recent fires in central Florida. BellSouth requests that the waiver apply to the Bunnell, Daytona, Flagler Beach, Palm Coast, Pierson, and Titusville exchanges.

Staff recommends that BellSouth's emergency request to waive the late payment charges for sixty days to existing customers affected by the recent fires in the central east coast area should be approved (Attachment A). BellSouth should file a tariff reflecting the sixty (60) day waiver of late payment charges. This tariff should be filed within five (5) days of this Agenda to be administratively approved with an effective date of July 21, 1998.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1, the tariff should become effective on July 21, 1998. If a protest is filed within 21 days from the issuance date of the Order, the tariff should remain in effect pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed. (Brown)
