WorldCom only reduced interLATA rates for World One. For the other products WorldCom has oniy one rate schedule, therefore the percent reduction for intraLATA was no greater than interLATA.

WoridCom determined what percentage of our Florida market was attributed to Commercial, Residential, Biztel, and Wholesale sectors. Then the total savings were allocated between each sector based on this percentage and then flowed through in the products listed.
