MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Easy Cellular, Inc. d/b/a Telcom Plus ("Easy Cellular") herewith files this Motion for Extension of Time and as basis would show:

- 1. On June 1, 1998, Easy Cellular filed a Complaint against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") for violations of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. On June 22, BellSouth filed its Answer and asserted a Counterclaim against Easy Cellular. The answer to the Counterclaim is due July 17, 1998.
- 2. In order to fully review the allegations raised in the Counterclaim and develop responses, Easy Cellular would request an extension of two weeks so that the answer to the Counterclaim would be due July 31, 1998. This will afford Easy Cellular an opportunity to fully review the Complaint and confer with BellSouth.
- 3. Counsel for BellSouth has been advised that Easy Cellular was going to request this extension and she has no objection to the extension of time. Further, Easy Cellular does not believe that granting the extension will adversely affect any party. A hearing on this complaint is not schedule until December and the extension will not interfere with that date.
