TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company")
hereby submits its Statement of the Issues and Positions to be
taken up at hearing scheduled to commence on August 26, 1998 in the
above docket.

Issue No. 1: What is the appropriate final environmental cost recovery true-up amount for the period ending March 31, 1998?

Tampa Electric's Position: \$351,717 overrecovery.

(Witness: Zwolak)

Issue No. 2: What is the estimated environmental cost recovery true-up amount for the period April 1, 1998 through September 30, 1998?

Tampa Electric's Position: \$80,017 underrecovery for the period April 1, 1998 through September 30, 1998. However, if the currently approved rates were extended through December 31, 1998, the estimated environmental cost recovery true-up amount for the period April 1, 1998 through December 31, 1998 would be an underrecovery of \$143,228.

Issue No. 3: What is the end of period total environmental cost recovery net true-up amount as of September 30, 1998?

Tampa Electric's Position: \$271,700 overrecovery through

September 30, 1998. However, if the currently approved rates were extended through December 31, 1998, the end of period total environmental cost recovery net true-up amount as of December 31, 1998 would be an overrecovery of \$208,489.

Issue No. 4: What is the appropriate projected environmental cost recovery amount for the pariod October 1, 1998 through December 31, 1998?

Tampa Electric's Position: \$1,152,326. (Witness: Zwolak)

Issue No. 5: What should be the effective date of the new environmental cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

Tampa Electric's Position: The factor should be effective beginning with the specified environmental cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period October 1998 through December 1998. Billing cycles may start before October 1, 1998, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 1998, so that each customer is billed for three months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective. (Witness: Zwolak)

Issue No. 6: What are the appropriate Environmental Cost Recovery Factors for the period October 1998 through December 1998 for each rate group?

Tampa Electric's Position: The appropriate factors are the current rates approved in PSC Order No. PSC-98-0408-FOF-EI, as follows:

RS, RST

0.033 cents/kwh

GS, GST, TS

0.033 cents/kwh

GSD, GSDT

0.033 cents/kwh

GSLD, GSLDT, SBF, IS1 IST1, SBI1, SBIT1, IS3, IST3, SBI3, SBIT3

0.031 cents/kwh

SL, OL

0.032 cents/kwh
