GTEFL understands that it must file a request for confidential classification when OPC notifies GTEFL what confidential information, if any, it plans to use in this proceeding.

All of the information at issue falls within Florida Statutes §364.183(3)(e), which defines the terms "proprietary confidential business information" to include "information ACK _ relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive AFA _ APP _ business of the provider of that information." In a competitive business, any such CAF _ CTR _ it pertains. This unfair advantage skews the operation of the market, to the ultimate EAG _ LEG ---- detriment of the consumer.
