Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, then NAI will have 20 days from issuance of the Commission's show cause order to respond in writing why it should not be fined in the amount proposed. If NAI timely responds to the show cause order, this docket should remain open pending resolution of the show cause proceeding. If NAI does not respond to the Commission's order to show cause, the fine should be deemed assessed. Staff recommends that, if NAI fails to respond to the order to show cause, and the fine is not received within five business days after expiration of the show cause response period, NAI's certificate should be cancelled, and this docket closed administratively.
