Comes now Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership ("Sprint"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Request for Confidential Classification.

- By letter dated July 10, 1998, the Division of Communications of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") requested certain information from Sprint relating to the status of local exchange competition in the business and residential markets.
- Sprint responded to the request of the Division of Communications on August 5, 1998. Sprint indicated that its response to question numbered 3(c) was confidential and proprietary.
- Sprint also filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification on August 5, 1998.
- Sprint considers its response to question 3(c) to contain proprietary confidential business information as defined in Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
- The information contained in this response is proprietary to Sprint and includes information containing the number of Sprint's business access lines within the State of Florida. This is competitive information and clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florian Administrative Code.
- 6. The information for which Sprint seeks confidential classification is not publicly available. It is not made available to persons outside of Sprint and is made available only to Sprint employees on a "need to know" basis. Sprint has treated and
