What has been happening all over the country with telephone bills since deregulation is a ripoff of the public. We are bing a la carted to the poor house. BellSouth bills now charge \$3.50 for Interstate Toll Access, \$.12 for Telecommunications Access System Act Surcharge, \$.93 for Universal Connectivity Charge, and \$.85 for Carrier Line Charge. With a local and long distant carrier, how many connecting charges can there be?

With an elderly person confined to a wheelchair, I feel I must list my aunt annual for "No Sales Solicitation" to avoid fraud and I feel I must insist on "Listing-not printed in directory" for the same reason.

My aunt is living on her own money praying to die before it runs out and forces her onto programs such as Medicade. A little help for elderly in maintaining their dignity would be appreciated.
