

The FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION will consider at its November 17, 1998, Agenda Conference, Docket No., 981242-EI, Application of Florida Power & Light Company for Authority to Issue and Sell Securities During the Calendar Year 1999 Pursuant to Section 366.04, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-8, Florida Administrative Code. The Company asserts that the amount of all equity and long-term debt securities issued, sold, exchanged or assumed and all liabilities and obligations assumed as guarantor, endorser, or surety will not exceed in aggregate \$1.6 billion during calendar year 1999 (January 1, 1999, to December 31, 1999). FPL seeks permission to enter into forward refunding or forward swap contracts during calendar year 1999. In conjunction with these forward contracts, FPL seeks permission to issue and sell up to \$151 million of securities through December 31, 2002, which would be committed to deliver under these forward contracts. In addition, FPL seeks to issue short-term unsecured promissory notes
