PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of the amendment is to allow a nonresidential customer to use its parent or affiliate company as a guarantor of bills even if the guarantor is not a customer of the utility.

SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: Guarantors of nonresidential gas customer bills.

THE PRELIMINARY TEXT OF THE PROPOSED RULE DEVELOPMENT IS:

25-7.083 Customer Deposits.

- (1) No Change.
- (a) The applicant for service furnishes a satisfactory guarantor to secure payment of bills for the service requested. For residential customers. at satisfactory guarantor shall, at the minimum, be a customer of the utility with a satisfactory payment record. For non-residential customers, a satisfactory quarantor need not be a customer of the utility. Each utility shall develop minimum financial criteria that a proposed quarantor must meet to qualify as a satisfactory quarantor. A copy of the criteria shall be made available to each new non-residential customer upon request by the customer. A guarantor's liability shall be terminated when a residential customer whose payment of bills is secured by the guarantor meets the requirements of subsection (6) of this rule. Guarantors providing security for payment of residential customers' bills shall only be liable for bills contracted at the service address contained in the contract of guaranty.
