CASE BACKGROUND

Zephyrhills Cinema 6, obtained Florida Public Service Commission Pay Telephone Certificate Number 3408 on August 25, 1993.

On December 11, 1997, the Division of Administration mailed the regulatory assessment fee (RAF) notice by certified mail. Staff received the return receipt from the United States Postal Service showing that the RAF notice was signed for and delivered on December 15, 1997.

By memorandum dated June 29, 1998, the Division of Administration advised staff that Zephyrhills Cinema 6 had not paid its 1997 RAF, plus statutory penalties and interest for the years

1993, 1994, 1995, and 1997. On July 29, 1998, the Commission received the minimum \$50 for 1997 RAF; however, the company did not pay the statutory penalties and interest for the years 1993, 1994, 1995, and 1997.

This item was deferred from the September 1, 1998 Agenda Conference at the company's request. On September 14, 1998, the company paid all the past due statutory penalties and interest, and made a proposed settlement offer to pay a \$100 contribution and pay future regulatory assessment fees by January 30 of each year. Therefore, staff believes the following recommendations are appropriate.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Zephyrhills Cinema 6 to resolve the apparent violations of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should accept Zephyrhills Cinema 6's settlement offer. Any contribution should be paid by the company within five business days from the effective date of the Commission Order. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. (Isler)

STAFF ANALYSIS: Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, requires the payment of regulatory assessment fees by January 30 of the subsequent year for telecommunications companies, and provides for penalties and interest as outlined in Section 350.113, Florida Statutes, for any delinquent amounts.

On June 29, 1998, staff learned that Zephyrhills Cinema 6 had not submitted the regulatory assessment fees for 1997, along with statutory penalties and interest charges for the years 1993, 1994, 1995, and 1997.

After staff opened this docket but prior to filing the recommendation, on July 29, 1998, Zephyrhills Cinema 6 paid the regulatory assessment fees for 1997. However, the company did not

pay the past due statutory penalties and interest charges. On August 20, 1998, staff filed its recommendation to fine the company \$500 for nonpayment of the statutory penalties and interest charges.

On August 28, 1998, the president of the company contacted staff and indicated that he did not want his certificate canceled and would do what is necessary to keep it. He advised that he would be unable to attend the September 1 Agenda Conference and requested a deferral to allow him to time to review his options. The Commission granted the company's request for a deferral.

In recognition of its apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, on September 14, the company paid in full all past due statutory penalties and interest charges, offered to contribute \$100 to the State General Revenue Fund, and promised to pay the regulatory assessment fees by January 30th of each year in the future. (ATTACHMENT A) Staff believes the terms of the settlement agreement as summarized in this recommendation should be accepted. Any contribution should be paid by the company within five business days from the effective date of the Commission Order. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.
