3. FCWC has the financial and technical ability to provide service to the customers identified in paragraph 2. FCWC is a large, multi-county operation in the State of Florida, and has been in the water and wastewater utility business since 1965. FCWC's operations are financially well supported, and the technical support and expertise are firmly in place. The proposed extension is not explored to have any impact in these regrets.

 a) Avatar Properties Inc. has requested FCWC to provide water and wastewater service to Area A.

b. Property owners Davis and Knowles have requested water service within Area B. Their existing water systems are in need of repair and they would rather connect to a central system than make repairs. The remainder of Area B is included because it is an "island" of unserved territory. Florida Cities believes it likely that other property owners within Area B will have problems with their own on-site systems. No other utilities have facilities in the area. The entire Area B is included in the proposed extension to avoid needless repetitive filings for very small extensions in an area that can logically be served only by FCWC.

 There are no existing facilities other than FCWC's facilities within the immediate geographical area capable of providing water and wastewater service to the proposed extension.

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this plant is 0.440 million gallons per day (mgd), with flows for the peak day at 0.710 mgd. The permitted treatment capacity is 1.00 mgd. This extension will add an average daily demand of 0.020 mgd and a peak demand of 0.031 mgd. There is a total of 800,000 gallons of storage to handle peak demand. There is sufficient water treatment capacity to serve the proposed territorial extension.

The Barefoot Bay Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant will serve the (b) proposed wastewater territory extension. The average daily flow for the twelve-month period ended August 1998 is 0.546 mgd, with maximum day flow at 1.581 mgd. The permitted capacity is currently 0.750 mgd. The permit for this facility is based on annual average daily flow (AADF)--not peak daily flow. The AADF of 0.546 mgd is well within the permitted capacity of the plant. A hydraulic peaking factor of 3.0 was used in the design of this plant. The peak daily flow of 1.581 mgd is handled by the plant without any degradation in the quality of service. This extension will add an average daily flow of 0.020 mgd and a peak day flow of 0.053 mgd. The developer of Area A will provide for adequate effluent disposal by taking back and reusing at least the same amount of wastewater generated by the parcel, as reclaimed water. That developer will construct all necessary reclaimed water mains and dedicate them to FCWC. (Beccause of the relatively small size of the individual parcels within Area B, and their remote location from the wastewater treatment plant, it would not be feasible to serve Area B with reclaimed water.) There is sufficient wastewater treatment plant capacity to serve the proposed territorial extension.

(c) Detailed information as to the capacity of the existing lines is as follows:

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Area A: Avatar Property

The Avatar Property will be incorporated into the Crystal Bay development, which was included in the territory extension granted by Order PSC-98-0360-FOF-WS. The developer will connect new water mains to existing 6-inch mains at Midway Street and Floral Drive. The new development requires 1000 gallons per minute (gpm) at 20 pounds per square inch (psi) pressure. Flow tests at nearby fire hydrants produced 1200 gpm at 20 psi. Wastewater collection and transmission mains will be installed by the developer and will be connected directly to the Barefoot Bay Advanced Wastewat.r Treatment Plant. No existing wastewater collection or transmission mains will be used.

Area B: Fleming Grant/ Micco

Property owners requesting water service within Area B will install and connect new water mains to an existing 6-inch main at Brown Road and Marlin Circle; and an existing 10-inch main at Sebast' in Road and Micco Road. Property owners requesting wastewater service within Area B will install and connect new collection mains to the existing collection system at Brown Road and Micco Road.

14. In FCWC's most recent extension application (Docket No. 971236-WS) Commission Staff and FCWC discussed whether it was appropriate for FCWC to file for a new class of service for the potential new customers in the territory considered therein. As indicated in the February 6, 1998 letter from Charles H. Hill to counsel for FCWC, attached hereto as Exhibit 5, Staff acknowledged that such filing would be premature at that time, since no

construction had been started by the developer, and that the utility was therefore uncertain as to what, if any, reuse change it would request in its tariff.

The status of the development considered in said Docket No. 971236-WS remains unchanged. The development is currently the subject of the development review process with Brevard County and no associated water, wastewater or reuse permits have been applied for. The developer is planning to purchase Area A proposed within the instant application and include it within the same development. No construction within the extension approved within Docket No. 971236-WS or within the Area A proposed herein has been started at this time. Thus, it remains premature for FCWC to apply for a new class of service for the potential reuse customers.

15. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has issued the following permits for the systems serving or proposed to serve the requested extension:

16 No construction will be required on the part of FCWC at this time for the proposed extension. The developer of Area A and property owners needing service within Area B will construct the facilities required to extend service to their respective property. Any maintenance or repair of existing facilities occasioned by the extension will have minimal, if any, impact upon FCWC's capital structure.

17 Given FCWC's broad existing customer base, the proposed extension is not expected to impact either its monthly rates or service availability charges.

18 The original and two copies of proposed tariff sheets, which include the proposed extension areas, are attached as Composite Exhibit 6

19 Certificates Nos. 7-W and 3-S are identified as Composite Exhibit 6 and have been furnished to the Staff of the Commission.

20. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code, the filing fee for the application is \$200.00 (\$100.00 for water and \$100.00 for wastewater.) A check in that amount payable to the Commission accompanies this application.

21. (a) Pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(2), Florida Administrative Code, FCWC obtained from the Commission a list of government authorities and certificated water and wastewater utilities located within the County in which the territory proposed to be served is located.

(b) FCWC will provide a copy of a Notice by regular mail to the governmental authorities and certificated utilities required under Rule 25-30.030(5) (a) through (h), Florida Administrative Code, as listed on the document referred to in paragraph 20(a) hereinabove. This notice will be given no later than seven days after the date the application is filed.

(c) FCWC will provide a copy of a Notice by regular mail to the owners of real property (as reflected on the local tax rolls) located within the proposed extension, pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(6), Florida Administrative Code. This notice will be given no later than seven days after the date the application is filed.

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(d) Arrangements have been made with "Florida Today," a newspaper of general circulation in the territory proposed to be added, to publish the Notice. The publication of notice is expected no later than seven days after the date the application is filed.

22 Order No. PSC-97-0516-FOF-WS is the most recent order of the Commission estat!ishing or amending the existing water and wastewater rates and charges for the Barefoot Bay system.

23 An affidavit that indicates FCWC has tariffs and annual reports on file with the Commission is attached hereto as E thibit 8

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

AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER

Agreement made December 31, 1986, between Avatar Otilities Inc. of Florida, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida having a principal office at 2112 Gulf Gate Drive, Sarasota, County of Sarasota, State of Florida 33581, and Florida Cities Water Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, having a principal office and place of business at 2112 Gulf Gate Drive, Sarasota, County of Sarasota, State of Florida 33581.

RECITALS

The boards of directors of the respective corporations deem it desirable and in the best interest of the corporations and their shareholders that Avatar Utilities Inc. of Florida be merged into Florida Citles Jater Company.

For the reasons set forth above, and in consideration of the nutual covenants and promises of the parties hereto, the constituent corporations agree, pursuant to Section 607.227, Florida Statutes, that Avatar Utilities Inc. of Florida shall be merged into Florida Cities Water Company as a single corporation; and the parties agree to and prescribe the terms and conditions of such merger, the method of carrying it into effect, and the manner of handling the shares of Avatar Utilities Inc. of Florida, as bereinafter.

1. Surviving Corporation.

a. Avatar Utilities Inc. of Florida shall be the subsidiary corporation, and all references in this plan of marger to "subsidiary corporation" shall be to Avatar Utilities Inc. of Florida.

b. Florida Cities Water Company shall be the surviving corporation which owns all of the issued and outstanding stock of the above-named subsidiary corporation, and all references in this plan of merger to "surviving corporation" shall be to Florida Cities Water Company.

2. Management.

a. The articles of incorporation of Florida Cities Water Company shall continue to be its articles of incorporation following the effective date of the marger, until the same shall be altered, or amended.

b. The bylaws of Florida Cities Water Company shall be and remain the bylaws of the surviving corporation until altered; amended, or repealed. έ.

c. The officers and directors of Florida Cities Water Company in office on the effective date of the merger shall continue in office and shall constitute the directors and officers of Florida Cities Water Company for the term elected until their respective successors shall be elected or appointed and gualified.

3. Rights, Privileges, etc.

a. On the effective date of the merger, Florida Cities Mater Company shall possess all the rights, privilegas, immunities, powers, and franchises of a public and private nature, and shall be subject to all of the restrictions, disabilities and duties of the subsidiary corporation; and all of the property, real, personal and mixed, and all debts due on whatever account, and all other choses in action and all and every other interest of or other choses in action and all and every other interest of or belonging to or due to the subsidiary corporation shall be deemed to be transferred to and vested in Florida Cities Mater Company without further act or deed, and the title to any property or any interest therein, vested in the subsidiary corporation shall not revert or be in any wy impaired by reason of the merger.

b. On the effective date of the marger, Florida Cities Nater Company shall be deemed responsible and liable for all the liabilities and obligations of the subsidiary corporation; and any claims existing by or against the subsidiary corporation may be prosecuted to judgment as if the marger had not taken place, or Florida Cities Water Company may be substituted in place of the subsidiary corporation. The rights of the creditors shall not be impaired by this marger. Florida Cities Water Company shall execute and deliver any and all documents which may be required for it to assume or otherwise comply with the outstanding obligations of the subsidiary corporation.

4. Conversion of Shares.

Florida Cities Water Company at present owns all of the outstanding shares of stock of the subsidiary corporation. Upon the effective date of the merger, all the outstanding shares of stock of the subsidiary corporation shall be surrendered and cancelled. The shares of common stock of Florida Cities Water Company, whether authorized or issued on the effective date of the merger shall not be converted, exchanged, or otherwise affected as a result of the merger, and no new shares of stock be issued by reason of this merger.

5. Expenses of Merger.

Florida Cities Water Company shall pay all the expenses of accomplishing the merger.

6. Subsequent Acts.

If at any time Florida Cities Water Company shall consider on be advised that any further assignment or assurances in law are necessary or desirable to vest or to perfect or confirm of record in Florida Cities Water Company the title to any property or rights of the subsidiary corporation or to otherwise carry out the provisions hereof, the proper officers and directors of the subsidiary corporation as of the effective date of the merger shall execute and deliver any and all proper assignments and assurances in law, and de all things necessary or proper to vest, perfect, or confirm title to such property or rights in Florida Cities Water Company and to otherwise carry out the provisions hereof.

7. Abandonment of Marger.

At any time prior to the filing of the articles of perger with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, the proposed merger may be abandoned by Florida Cities Water Company pursuant to this provision.
