Dear Mr. Hill:

On behalf of Florida Water Services Corporation ("Florida Water"), I offer the following comments in response to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) letter which addressed the Florida Water's application for territory expansion in Marion County.

Florida Water and Marion County signed settlement agreement concerning this matter on September 1, 1998. This agreement outlines the respective areas that Florida Water and Marion County will serve surrounding Florida Water's current water and wastewater territory. The attached water and wastewater map (4 copies of each enclosed) show the agreed-upon service areas.

Florida Water maintains that this settlement is consistent with the County's Comprehensive Plan; and, apparently, the County agrees. The Comprehensive Plan announces the desirability of centralized water and sewer rather than wells and septic tanks. In fact, Marion County's Comprehensive Plan states, "[u]pon completion of the County wide wastewater master plan and sanitary sewer master plans, the County shall amend the comprehensive plan to reflect the results of the master plans. The comprehensive plan amendment shall address the provision of wastewater and sanitary sewer facilities consistent with the comprehensive plan's timeframes of 1999 and 2004."

Policy 4.3 of the Potable Water Sub-Element of the Comprehensive Plan states, "Private utilities which are not under any regulatory enforcement action and which have adequate potable water facility capacity for the proposed expansion may provide service to contiguous development within the unincorporated area of the county." Policy 5.3 of the Sanitary Sewer Sub-Element, states "Private utility systems which have sufficient sewage treatment capacity may provide

services to contiguous and adjacent development within the unincorporated areas of the county." In fact, Policy 4.9 of the Future Land-Use Element states, "Centralized sewer shall be the preferred method of wastewater treatment for all development in Environmentally Sensitive Overlay Zones." This development is regardless of densities or land use. And it goes without saying that centralized water and wastewater service promotes environmental protection.

I should note that the DCA comments do not reflect the latest revision to Florida Water's territory expansion filed with the FPSC. An amendment to the original application to exclude the Spruce Creek Reserve was filed after the DCA's comment letter. The proposed service territory is attached.

The DCA also contends that much of the requested service territory has a rural land use designation and is not appropriate for central water and wastewater services. The latest Marion County Comprehensive Plan for the Marion Oaks and Florida Highlands areas, which are included in the proposed territory, designates these areas as rural land uses. These areas are currently approved for development and will have centralized water and sewer service. It is Florida Water's contention that it is the County's intent to have all of these areas served with public water and wastewater if feasible regardless of the designation as evidenced by the above mentioned Comprehensive Plan regulations.

Finally, granting Florida Water the expanded franchise area in Marion County in no way conveys approval for development, nor does it supplant the County's control over land use/planning. The County Planning Department retains control over development. It can approve or reject potential development plans. Although Florida Water may obtain a water and wastewater certificate from the PSC, Florida Water cannot provide service unless that development is approved by the appropriate governmental agencies. Therefore, approving Florida Water's expanded territory does not stop the County from rejecting development permit applications.

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

On April 1, 1998, Florida Water Services Corporation (FWSC or utility) filed an application for amendment of its water and wastewater certificates to add territory in Marion County. On May 1, 1998, Marion County (Marion or County) filed an objection to FWSC's motion and requested a hearing on its objection. Accordingly, a hearing was scheduled for January 26, 1999. Numerous County residents also filed letters indicating their objection to FWSC's application. However, these letters did not indicate whether the residents wished to participate at hearing as parties.

On September 14, 1998, Marion filed a stipulated agreement entered into by the County and FWSC, resolving its objection to the utility's application. Along with the stipulated agreement, Marion filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest. Based on the parties' stipulated agreement and Marion's notice of withdrawal, staff would like to request that you recommend that the Chairman:

Cancel the Prehearing Conference currently scheduled on January 6, 1998; ACK -Cancel the Hearing scheduled on January 26-28, 1998. AFA . APP -Cancellation of the Prehearing and Hearing dates will allow staff to bring the parties' stipulated settlement to the Commission and will allow time to ascertain the intentions of the residents who CAF filed letters of objection to FWSC's application. I have included a memo from you to Chairman CMU _ Johnson requesting cancellation of the Prehearing Conference and Hearing. Thank you.
