

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Account

- Any intentional or de facto transfer or assignment of services supplied by Carrier without the expressed written authorization of Carrier shall be deemed a fraudulent use
- 0.4 Recording of telephone conversations employing Carrier-provided services is prohibited except as authorized by applicable federal and state law

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



Conditions

Customers are required to sign an authorization form to accept or decline a term plan. All Intrastate. Interstate, International, Outbound 800, International 800, Calling Card, Passport and Conference Call usage contributes towards monthly commitment levels and receives discounts. The Customer has the first 90 days of the term period to meet commitment.
