Recommendation: No. The Commission should deny Florida Power Corporation's petition for waiver of Rule 25-6.0437(7), Florida Administrative Code, because the petition was untimely filed and does not satisfy the statutory criteria for a rule waiver. The Commission should require FPC to perform a load research study for the period October 1998 through September 1999, submit the study's results to the Commission in December 1999, and notify the Commission immediately if any problems arise in data collection that preclude the timely filing of valid load research results which meet the requirements of the rule. Staff will further evaluate $\mathrm{FPC}^{\prime}$ s actions in this matter to determine whether show cause proceedings should be initiated in a separate docket.
