Dear Ms. Bayo:

On November 6, 1998, we sent you a letter advising you of the September 29, 1998 merger of Logix Communications Corporation and American Telco, Inc. Under the plan approved by the Board of Directors of Dobson Wireline Company, the two wholly owned subsidiaries merged and Logix Communications Corporation is the surviving entity. It should be clearly noted that this transaction will not result in a change of control or ownership of either of the entities because Dobson Wireline Company, prior to this transaction, had already owned 100% of all of the outstanding classes of stocks in both companies.

	Currently, both Logix Communications Corporation and American Telco, Inc. are
	authorized to provide resold toll services in your state. The combined company will operate
