This docket has been opened to handle an amendment to interconnection agreement between BellSouth and "MFS Communications Company, Inc." I found from Tanya at Bell that the initial agreement was approved in Docket 971611-TP, and was an agreement between BellSouth and WorldCom. I asked Tanya about the difference in names, and she said she understood there had been a name change from WorldCom to MFS. I found Docket 970900, which concerned WorldCom and MFS and transferred control, canceled a cert, etc (please look at the order--97-1135--to see what all it DID do!)...

My concern is: The initial agreement was between BellSouth and WorldCom, holder of an ALEC certificate. This amendment is between BellSouth and "MFS Communications Company, Inc." which is NOT an ALEC holder (perhaps it is the parent of one?); can we amend an agreement in this fashion? What about the matter of having an ALEC certificate?

We will complete processing of the amendment and send it on the CMU and LEG, but I wanted to raise this question in case there was a need to clarify the name as part of the agreement. Kay
