Dear PSC,

As a customer of Florida Power and Light I consider it very important for to me to know about the fuels the utility is purchasing, and using, to produce electricity.

In particular there are two unfolding scenarios related to the electricity industry that are causing me concern to want to know more about the utility's fuel-mix, than at any other time in the past.

In the first scenario, greenhouse gas emissions, caused by the burning of fossil fuels, are probably disrupting our climate in an irreversible fashion. In the second scenario, there is the promise that, through deregulation of the electric industry, consumers may one day choose their electricity supplier. In the latter eventuality, thinking people will then have the choice, either by conscience or by pocketbook, to purchase electricity produced from either sustainable or non-sustainable energy sources.

In the absence of such electricity supplier choice in our state and the concerns that thinking Floridians have about damage to our fragile environment, a proposed PSC rule requiring that our electric utilities inform their customers directly about the fuels being used in electricity production is very welcome indeed.

Most Floridians have no idea how their electricity is produced and most have probably not thought about it until recently, that is.

With the continual media focus on the prospects of global warming and anecdotal experience of recent climate extremes, more consumers are asking questions about our energy choices. And our utilities' fuel choices go to the heart of it. The consumer is wanting to be educated and there is a willing cadre of educators and concerned individuals who have already taken up the challenge. But there will be no better time for the Public Service Commission to help the consumer than the present.

A quarterly insert in our electricity bills will tell us about utility fuel



usage in a simple, forthright manner. We will then have some of the information, we need to tell how healthy, or unhealthy, our energy diets really are and we might decide that more sustainable energy choices are worth paying a little more for. But without the information, energy education will languish while the rest of the United States passes us by in its rush to deregulation. An informed population can only help Florida.

Please include my support for the proposed rule requiring that our electric utilities provide quarterly bill inserts reporting the fuels used for electricity production. This is a requirement that will be very important for Florida's energy future


