# ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO ARBITRATED AGREEMENTS

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

Part II of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) sets forth provisions regarding the development of competitive markets in the telecommunications industry. Section 251 of the Act concerns interconnection with the incumbent local exchange carrier, while Section 252 sets forth the procedures for negotiation, arbitration, and approval of agreements.

Section 252(b) addresses agreements reached through compulsory arbitration. Specifically, Section 252(b)(1) states:

(1) Arbitration.-During the period from the 135th day to the 160th day (inclusive) after the date on which an incumbent local exchange carrier receives a request for negotiation under this section, the carrier or any other party to the negotiation may petition a State commission to arbitrate any open issues.

Section 252(b)(4)(C) states that the state commission shall resolve each issue set forth in the petition and response, if any, by imposing the appropriate conditions as required. This section requires that we conclude the resolution of any unresolved issues not later than 9 months after the date on which the local exchange carrier received the request under this section.

On December 16, 1996, we issued Order No. PSC-96-1531-FOF-TP, 960757-TP. By that Order, which in Docket No. Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. (MFS) and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., (BellSouth), we ordered BellSouth to file cost studies so that permanent rates could be established for specific unbundled network elements. On December 31, 1996, we issued Order No. PSC-96-1579-FOF-TP in Docket Nos. 960833-TP and 960846-TP. In that Order, which involved BellSouth, Communications of the Southern States (AT&T), Telecommunications Corporation and MCI Metro Access Transmission Services, Inc., (MCI), we again ordered BellSouth to file cost studies. Specifically, we ordered BellSouth to file cost studies on those elements for which we established interim rates so that permanent rates could be established.

On January 26-28, 1998, we held a hearing for the consolidated dockets. By Order No. PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP, issued April 29, 1998, we set permanent rates for unbundled network elements identified in Docket Nos. 960833-TP, 960757-TP, and 960846-TP. In accordance with Order No. PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP, the parties were to submit amendments to their arbitration agreements memorializing and implementing our decisions in that Order by May 29, 1998. On that day, AT&T filed a Joint Motion with BellSouth for Extension of Time to File Revisions to the Interconnection Agreement. By Order No. PSC-98-0844-FOF-TP, we granted the Joint Motion for Extension of Time. On October 23, 1998, we issued an Order amending Order No.

PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP to correct a scrivener's error regarding a specific rate.

On November 24, 1998, the parties filed the required amendments to their respective Interconnection, Unbundling and Resale Agreements for our approval pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, by December 23, 1998. In this Order, we address only the amendments to the BellSouth/AT&T agreement and the BellSouth/MCI agreement. The amendment to the BellSouth/AT&T agreement is attached and incorporated herein as Attachment A. The amendment to the BellSouth/MCI agreement is attached and incorporated herein as Attachment B.

Upon consideration, we find that the amendments submitted by the parties in Dockets Nos. 960833-TP and 960846-TP comport with our Orders in these dockets. Thus, we hereby approve the amended agreements in accordance with Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Based on the foregoing, it is therefore

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the amendment submitted by AT&T Communications of the Southern States and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., which is attached and incorporated herein as Attachment A, is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that the amendment submitted by MCI Telecommunications Corporation and MCI Metro Access Transmission Services, Inc. and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., which is attached and incorporated herein as Attachment B, is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that Dockets Nos. 960846-TP and 960833-TP shall be closed.

If a system or process is developed exclusively for certain carriers, however, those costs shall be recovered from the carrier who is requesting the customized system.

The parties acknowledge the Florida Public Service Commission's language in its Order No. PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP dated April 29, 1998 in Docket No. 960833-TP stating: "... BellSouth has a statutory obligation to negotiate or arbitrate this issue when requested to do so by a CLEC" and "... we strongly encourage the parties to negotiate in good faith to establish rates for OSS functions. If, however, the companies are unable to reach agreement through such negotiations, they may of course seek our guidance." (Revised 7/25/98)

# SECOND AMENDMENT TO MCImetro/BELLSOUTH INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT DATED JUNE 19, 1997

Pursuant to this Amendment to MCImetro/BellSouth Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment"), for the state of Florida, MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. ("MCIm") and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties," hereby agree to amend the MCImetro/BellSouth Interconnection Agreement dated June 19, 1997 ("Interconnection Agreement")

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, MCIm and BellSouth hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. On April 29, 1998 the Florida Public Service Commission issued Order No. PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP, in Dockets Nos. 960757-TP, 960833-TP, and 980846-TP. This Order set final rates for certain rate elements which were previously ordered as interim, pending filing of cost studies. On October 23, 1998 the Commission issued an Amendatory Order to Order No. PSC-98-0604-FOF-TP to correct the final \$101.61 rate for DS-1 Facility Termination as set forth in Table 1, page 13 of the orginal Order, which was incorrect. The approved rate is \$99.79. The final rates as corrected are as set forth in the Rate Tables attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A consisting of three pages delineating the recurring and non-recurring charges for:
  - a) Network Interface Device (NID);
  - b) 2 wire and 4-wire loop distribution;
  - c) 2-wire ADSL compatible loop;
  - d) 2-wire and 4-wire HDSL compatible loop;
  - e) Physical collocation;
  - f) Virtual collocation;
  - g) Directory Assistance;
  - h) Dedicated Transport; and
  - i) 4-wire analog port
- 2. Attachment I of the Florida Interconnection Agreement is hereby amended to incorporate the final rates for those certain rate elements as set forth in Exhibit A of this Amendment.

- 3. All of the other provisions, including all other rates listed in Attachment I of the Florida Interconnection Agreement, dated June 19, 1997, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. Either or both of the Parties shall submit this Amendment to the Florida Public Service Commission on or before November 23, 1998 as ordered by the Florida Public Service Commission. However, the Parties acknowledge that the terms and/or rates of this Amendment were established pursuant to the afore-referenced Order of the Florida Public Service Commission. Any or all of the terms or rates of this Amendment may be altered or abrogated by a successful challenge to the Amendment and/or the Order requiring the Amendment and/or any order approving this Amendment as permitted by applicable law. By signing this Amendment, neither Party waives any right to pursue such a challenge.
- 5. Either or both of the Parties shall submit this Amendment to the Florida Public Service Commission or other regulatory body having jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Amendment, for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
