By providing customer testimony, a person does not become a party to the proceeding. To become an official party of record, you must file a Petition for Intervention at least five days before the final hearing, pursuant to the requirements contained in Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider whether Lake Utility Services, Inc. overcollected AFPI charges in Lake County

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and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on January 15, 1999. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
