MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

JUSTIFICATION

The material contained within the Proprietary Documents comprise highly confidential financial information that would be of significant benefit to competitors. By reviewing its financial information, competitors could determine the extent of Applicant's sister organization's operations, which could cause significant and possibly irroparable harm to Applicant and its sister company.
